James Goodman, PhD:

Dr. Goodman, as Past President, of Morehouse College School of Medicine, the first Black medical college from 1980-1992, has had a profound effect in educating underserved citizens. Dr. Goodman is an internationally acclaimed speaker, author and expert in healthcare management systems, psychiatry and social work, including foreign agencies. He has coordinated training and educational efforts throughout Africa, Asia and the Far East as well as the United States. As Senior Professor Associate for the Institute of Medicine for the National Academy of Sciences he formed research teams and policy for all aspects of healthcare for the United States. During the 1960's he was the Director for the Los Angeles City Health Department. He was Chairman and CEO of Managed Health Care Systems, Inc., Director, Office of International Training Agency for International Development, U.S. Department of State; and Vice Provost, University of Washington. Consulted for the Office of President of the Boeing Company, the Department of Army and the Department of Health and Human Services. He was named Seattle's Man of the Year in 1995.
